
Agenda Item: 3

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Manlief Property located at 2300 E. Loma Vista Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$680.00 for abatement request: remove excess fronds from palm trees on/adjacent to property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the MANLIEF PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE203191: remove excess fronds from palm trees on/adjacent to property.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Manlief Property located at 2300 E. Loma Vista Drive, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 05/20/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

In May of 2020, my office received two complaints. An inspection was conducted, violation(s) observed, and a notice was mailed to the property owner

In June of 2020, I conducted a second inspection, observed little to no change, and mailed a second notice to the owner

In August of 2020, I conducted a third inspection, observed little to no change at the property, so a notice was posted to the front of the structure

In October of 2020, I observed little to no change at the property. Two additional complaints were received by my office.

In November of 2020, I submitted the abatement request for the trimming of at least three trees, located on the property and/or adjacent right of way

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The owner(s) of this property, MICHAEL MANLIEF, have/has made little to no attempt to bring the property into compliance. MICHAEL MANLIEF have/has not had a prior abatement conducted on this property. Due to the failure of the property owner(s) to address this matter, a 180-day open abatement period is being sought for this property. I therefore request the City of Tempe Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda to be held on 01/05/2021 at 5pm, at the City of Tempe Council Chambers, located at 31 E. 5th Street, Tempe. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.8 Excessive, dead palm fronds

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.8 Please trim excessive, dead palm fronds from the palm trees located either on the property, or adjacent right of way

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$680.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
