
Agenda Item: 2

<u>ACTION</u>: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Mullin Property located at 1983 E. Huntington Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$477.00 for abatement request: remove unregistered and/or inoperable vehicles.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the MULLIN PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE204555: remove unregistered and/or inoperable vehicles.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Mullin Property located at 1983 E. Huntington Drive, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 07/15/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

In July of 2020, I visited the property and confirmed a violation of City Code related to either inoperable or unregistered vehicles. I mailed a violation notice to the property owners, requesting the violation be remedied.

In August of 2020, I visited the property and observed that the vehicles had been backed into the driveway, but not registered, so I mailed a second violation notice to the property owners, requesting the violation be remedied.

In September of 2020, I visited the property and observed little to no change with regards to the vehicles, as they continued to display expired registration. I mailed a third violation notice to the property owners, as an additional, unrelated violation was visibly present at the time of inspection, seeking remedy of each violation.

In October of 2020, I visited the property and observed little to no change with regards to the vehicles, as they continued to display expired registration. I then posted a violation notice to the front of the structure.

In December of 2020, I visited the property and observed little to no change with regards to the vehicles, as they continued to display expired registration. I then issued citations to both property owners, posting them to the front of the structure.

In January of 2021, I received a voicemail from Mrs. Mullin, stating she wanted to pay her citation, but was having difficulty with the Court website. She stated she was working towards registering, insuring, and relocating the vehicles from the driveway. I attempted to call her back but reached message preventing me from leaving her a voicemail.

In March of 2021, I visited the property and observed that tee shirts had been secured over the license plates of the vehicles, preventing the ability to view registration tags. No temporary tags were present in any window of the vehicles. I sought bids to abate the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The owner(s) of this property, DENNIS & VERONICA MULLIN, have/has made little to no attempt to bring the property into compliance. DENNIS & VERONICA MULLIN have/has not had a prior abatement conducted on this property. Due to the failure of the property owner(s) to address this matter, a 180-day open abatement period is being sought for this property. I therefore request the City of Tempe Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda to be held on 05/04/2021 at 5pm, at the City of Tempe Council Chambers, located at 31 E. 5th Street, Tempe. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.3 Unregistered or inoperable vehicles

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.3 Please register the unregistered vehicles, located in the driveway, or relocate the vehicles to a location compliant with all applicable laws. Please complete repair/replacement of tires, so that vehicle(s) no longer need jack stands to support them, or relocate the vehicle(s) to a location compliant with all applicable laws

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$ 477.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
