DIVERSITY & INCLUSION



- Developed recommendations to change the MYAC ordinance
- Notable Changes
 - Allow for proactive recruitment and outreach to all school and non-traditional settings
 - Membership to start at 9th grade
 - This will allow MYAC coomissioners to mentor 8th graders
 - Start session in September to allow for more event and project planning





Teen Professional Development



- Provided guidance on College Connect Tempe's presentation to 8th graders presented to Tempe Elementary Middle schools
- Developed a tip sheet for 8th graders to help transition to high school



Emotional Well-Being



- Provided technical guidance on building a website to promote mindfulness to youth
- Engaged in conversation with two CARE 7 Youth Specialists to process the idea of returning to inperson school
