

"Brittany Lane is seeking funds to reduce, and better manage the water consumption on their property. In seeking to accomplish this goal the Board has identified a large retention located at the rear of the property to convert from grass to rock. This area of grass is the largest portion of grass on the property, but also the least used due to its location. In converting to rock the Board will also be planting 7 new trees, in addition to the 7 existing trees in the retention.

Secondly, the Board has identified the next three largest areas of lawn on the property and seeks to retrofit the sprinkler heads to EPA Water Sense sprinklers for improved efficiency. The combination

"Brittany Lane is seeking funds to reduce, and better manage the water consumption on their property through a turf to rock conversion covering 12,084 square feet of converted area, and sprinkler retro fit in three main common areas where turf will be maintained.

The Board has had the topic of the grant program on their Board meeting agenda dating back to February 2020, discussing the project and possibilities in each meeting with invites for community participation since that time."

Conversion of the 12,084 square feet of turf and retrofit of remaining common area sprinklers will immediately reduce water consumption and cost and future landscaping expenses. The addition of 7 trees added to the 7 existing trees in the turf conversion will maintain appeal and provide needed shade. The savings benefits the community as a whole in better managing dues and keeping funds for community needs.

Project requires two chemical treatments to kill existing turf prior to rock placement. Treatments are best accomplished while summer Bermuda is in its active growth season. Both conversion and retrofit can be completed in fiscal year. Ongoing maintenance will be performed with routine landscape service.





Turf conversion of the area behind units 19-15 This area will have turf removed, all lawn irrigation terminated and one valve to be use for new drip irrigation to new and existing trees this will require tranching new pipe and multi port irrigation to all trees.

With only one entrance to this area will be using tractors to move materials next to unit 19 and RV lot as staging area.

The three areas to convert to H.E. Sprinkler heads will be around the pool, East side of unit 41 and West side of 29. These three areas will have all heads removed and replaced with approved H.E. heads (Hunter Pro) and MP nozzles this will require new head installation, trenching and pipe runs to make sure coverage is adequate. All areas will be tested and checked.






