You are charged with an offense that requires you to take action. Your appearance date, time and court location appears above your signature. Normal text and SMS rates apply. Please contact the court in which your case is filed should you desire to opt out of this service.

If you are required to pay fines, sanctions, penalties, fees, or other financial obligations as a result of this complaint and **you are unable to pay**, bring this to the attention of court staff or the judge as payment over time or other alternatives may be available. Do not ignore the complaint and the responsibility to pay as this my result in additional penalties and costs to you. CIVIL TRAFFIC

If you were charged with a civil traffic violation and you fail to appear or use an option as directed in this complaint, a default judgment will be entered against you, a monetary penalty will be imposed and your delinquent sanctions will be referred to a collection agency. Your driver's license or nonresident operating privilege will be suspended. Your license or operating privilege will remain suspended until the default judgment is addressed and you satisfy Motor Vehicle Division requirements (A.R.S. §28-1557).

You have up to four (4) options. You may need to choose more than one option if more than one violation is listed on the complaint.

OPTION 1- <u>Attend a defensive driving class</u>. One (1) eligible moving violation is dismissed and no points places on your driving record if you attend a defensive driving class. You must meet eligibility requirements and pay a registration fee on the day of the class. Class must be completed at least 7 business days prior to your court date. Go to <u>www.tempe.gov/court</u> to see a list of DDC eligible charges. **For Driving School information call (888) 334-5565 or visit www.azdrive.com**.

OPTION 2- Pay by phone (480) 350-8800 (For single charge complaints only), by mail or online at <u>www.tempe.gov/court</u>. Payment of sanctions is considered to be a plea of 'responsible' to the charge(s). Mail a check or money order (post-marked on or before the arraignment date) to the Tempe Municipal Court at 140 E. 5th Street, Tempe, AZ 85281. You do not have to appear in court if you waive your right to a hearing, enter a plea of responsible, and pay the sanction(s). There are additional fees added if you pay after the appearance date listed on the complaint, visit <u>www.tempe.gov/court</u> for more information.

OPTION 3- <u>Request a court hearing</u>. You have the right to a hearing before a judge who will determine whether you are responsible for the alleged violation(s).

OPTION 4- <u>Appear in court</u>. You can appear during business hours to pay the sanction(s), show proof of compliance, and/or request a hearing. If the court is closed on the appearance date indicated on this complaint, you must appear on the following business day at the time indicated. Bring your copy of the complaint with you.

CHILD PASSENGER RESTRAINT VIOLATIONS

Children Are Priceless Passengers (CAPP) is a voluntary program available to persons cited for violations of A.R.S. 28-907A and B (Child Restraint Law). Upon completion of the class offered through the Tempe Police Department, the sanction will be reduced to zero. BICYCLE DIVERSION CLASS

If you were cited for a City Code or Title 28 violation while operating a bicycle you may be eligible to attend this class for one eligible charge instead of paying the sanction. Upon paying a diversion fee at the court, attending and paying a class fee, the charge will be dismissed. CRIMINAL TRAFFIC OR CRIMINAL OFFENSE

You must appear personally or you may appear by having an attorney enter a notice of appearance on your behalf by your appearance date. If you fail to appear at court, a warrant will be issued for your arrest, your diver's license or nonresident operating privilege may be suspended and you will be charged with additional misdemeanor crim of violation of promise to appear (A.R.S. §13-3903). If the Court is closed on the appearance date indicated on this complaint, you must appear on the following business day at the time indicated. Bring your copy of the complaint with you.

CITY CODE VIOLATION OR PETTY OFFENSE

If you were charged with a petty offense and you fail to appear in court as directed in the complaint, a warrant will be issued for your arrest (A.R.S. §13-3903). If you were charged with a civil ordinance violation and you fail to appear as direction in this complaint, a default judgment will be entered, a monetary penalty will be imposed and your delinquent sanctions will be referred to a collection agency.

IF YOU ARE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE, your parent or guardian must accompany you to court (A.R.S. §8-323). If you fail to appear as directed in the complaint, the Court will direct the Motor Vehicle Division to suspend your driver's license or driving privilege.
