

### Rate Study Recommendation



Levelized rate increase of three (3) percent per year, over the next several years.

Additional 96-gallon recycling container		\$13.98



#### Recommended Commercial Rate Adjustments



- No rate adjustments to single container front load garbage or roll-off collection service.
- Reduce multiple container discount for front load garbage.
- Volume-based rate structure for front load recycling container sizes.
