

**ACTION:** Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Bursh Property located at 700 E. Loyola Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$786 for abatement request: landscape cleanup including dead tree removal, remove unregistered vehicle from property.

**RECOMMENDATION**: Staff – Approval of abatement

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the BURSH PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE211833: landscape cleanup including dead tree removal, remove unregistered vehicle from property.

#### **COMMENTS:**

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Bursh Property located at 700 E. Loyola Drive, R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 03/19/21, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

## **FINDINGS:**

03/19/2021 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for unregistered/inoperable vehicle. Code Inspector Sammy Baptiste inspected the property, and there was a Volvo vehicle parked in the driveway with expired tags and a flat tire. A notice was mailed to the property owner Eula Bursh.

04/02/2021 Code Inspector Sammy Baptiste inspected the property, and the vehicle was still in violation. A final notice was mailed

05/07/2021 Inspector Julie Scofield took over the case for Inspector Baptiste. Went to the property and the vehicle in question is still in violation. Another final notice was mailed to the owner.

05/20/2021 Hung up a pink hanger on the gate, asking for compliance or contact by 05/25/2021 to avoid a possible citation.

05/21/2021 Talked to the owner's son, Josh Bursh. He said that the vehicle should be taken care of by the following week.

06/02/2021 Re-inspected the property and the vehicle is still in violation.

06/07/2021 Another complaint for the property came in for over height grass and weeds and unregistered vehicles.

06/09/2021 A citation was issued for the unregistered vehicle. Pictures were taken to show the condition of the property. A notice for the landscape was mailed since there was grass and weeds growing in the gravel landscape.

06/29/2021 A final notice was mailed for the landscape. The citation has gone unpaid, and the violation with the vehicle still exists. Requesting bids for the cleanup of the property to include towing the unregistered vehicle and deteriorated landscape.

07/20/2021 Turning in the paperwork for the abatement hearing to be heard on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property at 700 E. Loyola Dr. due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3. B.3 AND 21-3. B.8. Bursh has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of 09/01/2021 located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.3 An inoperable vehicle or parts thereof outside of or under a roof area not enclosed

CC 21-3.b.8 Landscaping that is substantially dead, damaged or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or

presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or

portions thereof, including stumps

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.3 Please repair or remove vehicle from property.

CC 21-3.b.8 Remove grass and weeds from the gravel dead tree. Stumps need to be removed or cut to

ground level

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$786.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
