Rebates for Single Family Residential (SFR) and Multi-Family Residential (MFR) Customers

Landscape Conversion Rebate

Receive 25 cents per square foot of landscape, up to \$2,000 for SFR and \$3,000 for MFR, converted from grass to desert landscape.

TreeBate (SFR)

Receive a rebate of 100 percent, up to \$75, for the purchase price of desert lush plants.

High-Efficiency Toilet Rebate (SFR)

Receive a rebate of 50 percent of the purchase price, up to \$75, of a new high-efficiency toilet that flushes 1.28 gallons per flush or less.

High-Efficiency Irrigation Rebate

Upgrade an existing irrigation system with high efficiency spray nozzles, rain sensors and/or controllers and receive up to \$500.

Gray Water Recycling Systems Rebate

Receive a rebate of 50 percent, up to \$200 per household, for the purchase of gray water system components.

Indoor Fixtures Rebate (MFR)

Receive a rebate, up to \$5,000 per property, towards the purchase price of approved indoor high-efficiency fixtures, including toilets, urinals and shower heads.

Grant Funds for Capital Improvement Projects (MFR)

Apply to receive a grant through the Marianne Corder Neighborhood Grant Program for capital improvement projects, including water conservation-related projects.

Tempe offers commercial and non-residential rebates for HOAs, neighborhood associations, schools and businesses.
