# I-10 BROADWAY CURVE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATE



## Project Overview

An ADOT improvement project along I-10, including 11 miles of improvements that will enhance safety, reduce travel time and support the local, regional and state economies. Construction is anticipated to last up to four years.

### Notice to Proceed issued

ADOT issued the Notice to Proceed to begin construction on the Broadway Curve Project. The project work zone has three segments, as depicted in the map. At times, work will occur in all three segments simultaneously.

Most of the immediate construction will occur in the east segment on eastbound I-10, between Baseline and Ray roads. However, work will be reduced during the holiday season, between mid-November and early January 2022. Some construction activity that does not directly impact motorists will continue.
