

PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY - OCTOBER 2021

I. Background

The City of Tempe works to offer opportunities for play, shaded spaces, and comfort in our neighborhood parks. Towards that effort, a 20'x20' picnic ramada, shade structure, full rubber surfacing for the playground and trees are scheduled for Alegre Park. If there is not a majority support, in the form of written or online responses, for the addition of a picnic ramada, the city will explore additional shade in the park.

II. Outreach

Several bilingual methods were used to provide information to the public regarding the project, meeting and opportunities for input.

- Two direct mail postcards were sent to 1,702 households in the project area from University Dr. to Apache Blvd. and McClintock Drive to Smith Road, the first with meeting and survey information and the second as a reminder to provide comments.
- Notification email to neighborhood and homeowners' association contacts inviting them to attend the meeting or to comment online and share with their neighborhoods.
- Notification email to relevant Boards and Commissions inviting them to attend the meeting or to comment online.
- An open house was held on Sept. 27 at Alegre Park with approximately 5 attendees and a virtual public meeting was held on Sept. 30 with 3 attendees. A recording of the virtual meeting was made available online and viewed 9 times.
- The topic was posted on the project website for input from Sept. 27 through Oct. 14, 2021.
- Yard signs posted in heavily traversed park areas.





No Response:







4. Which color do you prefer for the ramada roof?





- Other______


Please select the enhanced amenity you would most like to see in Alegre Park:



Please select the enhanced amenity you would least like to see in Alegre Park:



Cleanliness of Alegre Park



- 7. Trash and mattresses often found in the park


Safety of Alegre Park

Comments on friendliness:


- 1. Awesome!
