Agenda Item 1 - Call to Order:

Teri Metros, Library Advisory Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

Agenda Item 2 - Call to the Audience:

- Keith Burke, Community Services Director, introduced Jessica Jupitus, incoming Deputy
 Community Services Director (Deputy) of Library Services. Burke announced that J. Jupitus will
 begin to serve in the Deputy role on December 6, 2021.
- K. Burke further introduced MJ Jupitus, and welcomed the Jupitus family to the City of Tempe and Library Advisory Board.
- K. Burke confirmed the attendance of Martha Carter, Tempe Leadership class member.

<u>Agenda Item 3 - Approval of the November 3, 2021, Library Advisory Board Meeting Minutes:</u> APPROVED

- Teri Metros, Library Advisory Board (Board) Chair, asked the Board members to review the unapproved meeting minutes document dated November 3, 2021.

Agenda Item 4 - Report: Friends of Tempe Public Library

- No report; Katie O'Connor, Interim Deputy Community Services Director of Library Services, announced that the Tempe Connections Café operated by the Friends of Tempe Public Library will host a meet and greet reception with grab-and-go pastries and refreshments for Jessica Jupitus, incoming Deputy Community Services Director of Library Services, from 8:30 to 10 a.m. on December 6, 2021.
 - o K. O'Connor further encouraged the Library Advisory Board members to attend the reception.

Agenda Item 5 - Staff Report: Katie O'Connor, Interim Deputy Community Services Director

- Katie O'Connor (K. O'Connor), Interim Deputy Community Services Director Library Services Division, gave the following information specific to Tempe Public Library operations:
 - 140 adults were engaged in programming during October 2021; programs included:
 - Writers' Connection;
 - Mystery Club;
 - iPhone/iPad Explained;
 - English Corner;
 - ASU DISC:
 - Great Books discussions;
 - I Wrote a Book, Now What?

- Coffee, Tea, and Books discussions;
- Sustainability: Landscape Trees for the Arizona Desert.
- Physical circulation of materials increased from July to October;
 - o Circulation of material in July 2021 totaled 30,649 uses;
 - Circulation of material in August 2021 totaled 31,965 uses;
 - Circulation of material in September 2021 totaled 31,345 uses;
 - Circulation of material in October 2021 totaled 32, 522 uses, an increase of 1,200 circulations (recovering from the slight post-summer reading decrease).
- Library eContent use remained relatively steady from July to October;
 - eContent activity in July 2021 totaled 29,661 uses;
 - eContent activity in August 2021 totaled 30,433 uses;
 - eContent activity in September 2021 totaled 27,381 uses;
 - eContent activity in October 2021 totaled 27,193 uses.
- eResource usage decreased slightly in October 2021, following the downturn post summer reading.
- **BrainFuse**, an eTutoring resource, should be available beginning in December 2021;
- Public access computers within the Library's computer lab saw 1,946 uses in October 2021;
 - The lab at Escalante Community Center saw 74 uses;
 - o The lab at North Tempe Multi-Generational Center saw 108 uses;
 - o The recently reactivated lab at Cahill Senior Center saw 28 uses.
- Tempe Public Library has an average attendance of 592 patrons per day, slightly down from 671 for the months of August and September 2021.
- K. O'Connor reported the following information specific to operations of Tempe Public Library's (Library) Youth and Teen Services areas:
 - Code Club, a class for youth ages six to 11-years-old to explore difference computer programming languages and logic, held four sessions with 18 total participants;
 - Kindergarten Readiness Workshop, a program for children ages four and five-years-old and their caregivers to practice school readiness skills, held one session with two

participants;

- o Homeschool Open Lab returned for daily use and had no participants in October 2021;
- PageTurners, a program hosted by Arizona State University honors students and designed to promote a positive relationship with reading, resumed in October for ages six to 12-yearsold (met three times with 61 total participants);
- Facebook Live Story Times continue with attendance totaling 424 views in October;
- The Youth and Teen Services Library Team hosted 'A Night at Hogwarts' on Friday, October
 29, with a total of 65 participants including parents, staff members, and teen volunteers.
- The Youth and Teen Services Area programmed a 'Spooktacular Week of Fun' from October 25 to October 31; over 25 pumpkins, 25 trick-or-treaters, and more than 20 ghosts visited Tempe Public Library's pumpkin patch.
- 16 Teen Volunteers earned a combined total of 59 service hours during October 2021;
- Anime Streamers held four sessions with a total of two participants;
- o **Game On** met four times with a total of 24 participants;
- Create Thursday held four sessions with a total of 16 participants;
- A second volunteer orientation occurred in October 2021 with a total of six teens;
- o Build Your Own Book, a teen-led program, had four participants.
- Virtual programming for teens continues; Teen Times and weekly Zoom Teen Hangouts continue to see a handful of participants each month.

- Katie O'Connor (K. O'Connor), Interim Deputy Community Services Director Library Services Division, gave the following update specific to **active recruitments** at Tempe Public Library:
 - The Adult Services Librarian I/II+ position was offered to Colleen Fincke; she will officially join the Adult Services team on Monday, November 22;
 - Tempe Public Library is currently accepting applications for a Library Assistant position within the Materials and Collections Development area;
 - Keith Burke, Community Services Director, announced the hiring of Jessica Jupitus, incoming Deputy Community Services Director of Library Services; Burke reported that J. Jupitus will begin in her role on Monday, December 6.
