



How to participate in person at a City Council meeting

Fill out and submit the Comment Card no later than 2 p.m. the day of the City Council meeting.

Visit <https://tempe.hylandcloud.com/AgendaOnline> to view the agendas of upcoming City Council meetings, which are typically available the Friday afternoon prior to the meetings.

If you want to speak or provide your written comments to City Council prior to the meeting for their review, please fill out the speaker/comment card by visiting: tempe.gov/CouncilComment

If you indicated on the speaker/comment card that you will be attending the meeting physically in the Council Chambers and would like to speak in-person, please make sure to arrive at the Chambers before the meeting begins – Visit <https://tempe.hylandcloud.com/AgendaOnline> to confirm the meeting start time.

The Mayor will call your name when it is your turn to speak. When you arrive at the podium, state your name and city of residence for the record. You will have a maximum of three (3) minutes to speak.

Alternatively, you may fill out a speaker card inside the Council Chambers and provide it to the City Clerk at the beginning of the meeting, or right before or after you speak.
