





 - Improves shade coverage
 - Increases seating
- Adaptable to multiple locations
 - 777 bus stops citywide
 - 312 existing shelters
 - 465 stops without shelters
 - Many with limited ROW
- Sustainable Design
 - Solar power
 - Recyclability
