
Agenda Item: 6

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the TL QIK STOP Property located at 3233 South 48th Street. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$1556.00 for abatement request, including Junk, trash and debris on property, Security on site.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff - Approval

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe - Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the TL QIK STOP PROPERTY (CM211465). The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CM211465: Junk, trash, debris. The request includes the following:

#### **COMMENTS:**

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the TL QIK STOP Property located at 3233 South 48<sup>th</sup> Street in the PCC-1, Planned Commercial Center Neighborhood District. ### FINDINGS:

06/10/22 The Code Compliance Division received complaint for junk, trash and debris. Inspected the property and found junk, trash and debris present to the east of the building

07/21/22 The Code Compliance Division received complaint for junk, trash and debris.

07/28/22 Inspected property and found junk, trash and debris present on east side of the parcel. Notice to comply mailed to owner. Bids sought for property abatement.

08/01/22 The Code Compliance Division received complaint for junk, trash and debris.

08/05/22 Posted notice to structure and mailed to property owner.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property at 3233 S 48TH ST due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3.b.1. TL QIK STOP MARKET INC has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. The property owner has been issued a civil citation and has failed to appear to court. The property has been previously abated for graffiti. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents a health hazard and an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer located at the Tempe City Council Chambers on 09/06/2022. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

#### Violation of City of Tempe Code 21-3.b.1

Filthy, littered, debris or trash-covered exterior areas, including exterior areas under any roof not enclosed by the walls, doors or windows of any building; including, but not limited to, areas that contain items such as cans, bottles, wood, metal, plastic, rags, boxes, paper, tires, auto parts; unused, inoperable, worn out or discarded appliances or other household items; lumber, scrap iron, tin and other metal not neatly piled, or anything whatsoever that is or may become a hazard to public health and safety, or that may harbor insect, rodent or vermin infestation. This subsection shall not be deemed to include items kept in covered bins or metal receptacles approved by the County Health Officer or this Code or any other ordinance of the City;

Please remove the trash, litter, junk, debris and/or stored items from the property (e.g. debris located along the east side of the parcel, etc.)

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$1,556.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate for judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
