#### **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

Essential job functions are the fundamental duties of a position: the things a person holding the job absolutely must be able to do.

To actively support and uphold the City's stated mission and values. To perform work in the installation, maintenance and repair of the City's water distribution, wastewater collection and stormwater collection systems. To coordinate related activities and projects and identify and resolve issues related to daily water distribution, wastewater collection and stormwater collection systems operations and maintenance. Areas of assignment may be rotated for cross-training opportunities and to satisfy operational need.

#### OTHER DUTIES AS ASSIGNED

Please note this job description is not designed to cover or contain a comprehensive listing of all activities, duties or responsibilities that are required of the employee for this job. Duties, responsibilities and activities may change at any time with or without notice.

- Follow safety regulations and safe work practices, including traffic/barricade compliance, proper trenching and shoring procedures and competent person and confined space entry procedures.
- Provide functional and technical direction to Utility Services' staff on daily assignments, training.
- Assist in planning and organizing work groups involved in the installation, maintenance and repair of water mains, valves, fire hydrants, water service lines and meter vaults and boxes.
- Perform preventive maintenance on water distribution, wastewater collection and stormwater infrastructure.
- Install "hot taps" on water mains; install taps on wastewater mains.
- Inspect, install, maintain, replace and repair water mains, valves, fire hydrants, water service lines, meters and related appurtenances.
- Inspect, install, maintain, replace and repair wastewater mains, manholes, cleanouts and related appurtenances.
- Inspect, install, maintain, replace and repair stormwater mains, catch basins, inlets, drains and drywells and related appurtenances.
- Utilize the City's Geographic Information System utility maps.
- Initiate, schedule, review, update and complete work orders using Tempe's asset management system.
- Enter, review and maintain data for accuracy in Tempe's asset management system.
- Review, approve and distribute reports.
- Assist employees in operating Tempe's asset management system.
- Dismantle, repair and rebuild broken or damaged fire hydrants.
- Inspect and perform wastewater cleaning on sewer mains using Jet-Vac truck; perform preventative maintenance on Jet-Vac truck.
- Respond to customer inquiries and prioritize, troubleshoot and make repairs as needed; complete fire flows and install and repair construction meters.
- Perform excavation and trenching activities including backhoe, Hydro X and crane.
- Inspect, verify, submit and confirm blue stake submissions for jobs.
- Ensure proper tools, supplies, training and other resources are available to aid in efficient crew deployment and job completion.
- Assess, review and submit traffic control plans with barricade companies.
- Serve on rotating list for standby, providing functional and technical direction.
- Provide Division back-up for Blue Stake and Closed-Circuit Television Inspector activities as needed.
- Perform related duties as assigned.
