HOPE Outreach by Zone

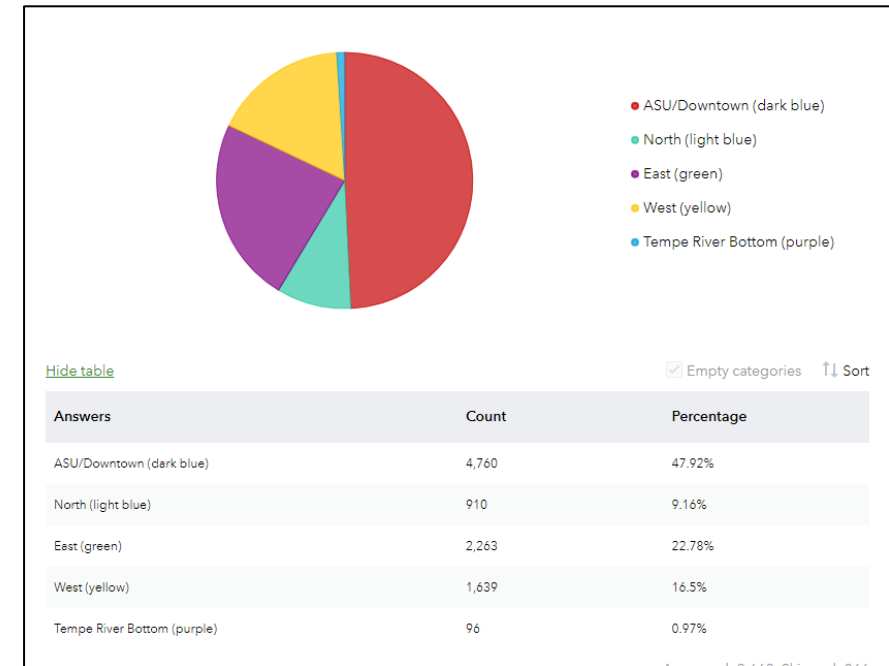

Reported Encampment's Follow Up

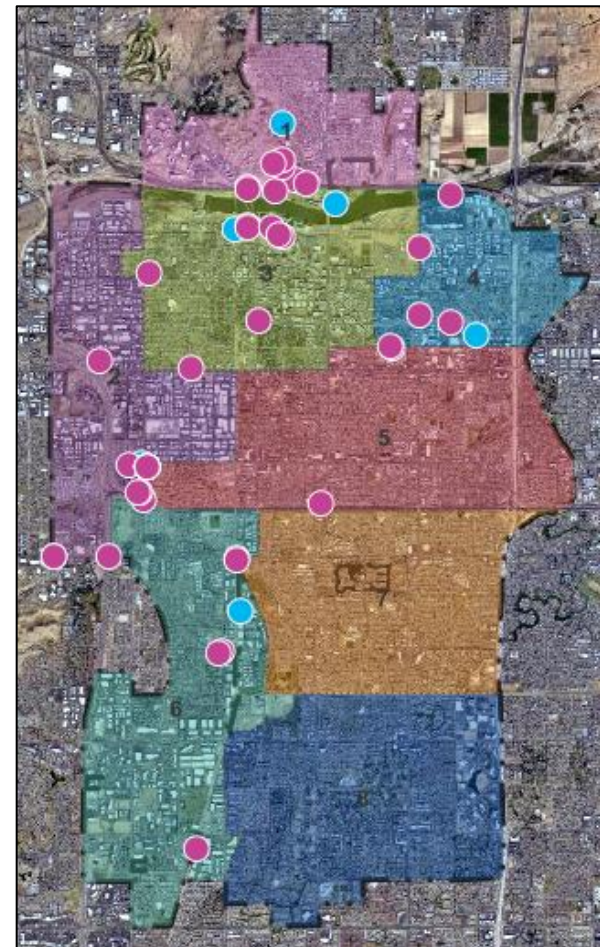
